

History of San Pedro Annual Festival Association



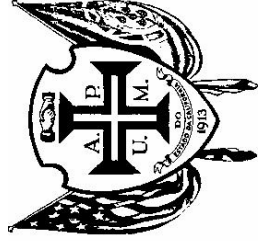
Established in 1922 by families from Madeira Island, the "Festa" was held for over 50 years as a community event. Descendants of the original founders are continuing the history of the Madeiran culture, restoring the San Pedro Park and hold an annual celebration in honor of St. Peter and the founders. Friends of San Pedro and SPA members are encouraged to attend the annual event on the last Sunday of June each year. Check the San Pedro Association website for details.

DIRECTIONS TO SAN PEDRO PARK:

Take I80 split east of Yolo Causeway and go north towards Sacramento Airport. Exit I80 at Reed Avenue, go east crossing Harbor Blvd. Directly after driving under a small railroad underpass, turn left onto Sunset Ave. At the next intersection, turn right at the Mecca Club onto Lisbon Avenue. Next right corner is North Hobson and the San Pedro Park is on the right. Parking is on the street.
